BiodivNBS Call for Transnational Research Proposals on "Nature-Based Solutions (NBS) for biodiversity, human well-being and transformative change"

Scope:

This call will aim at supporting research on biodiversity to gain a better understanding of the tipping points and trade-offs and underlying mechanisms affecting Nature-based Solutions (definition in box above, see also Eggermont et al. 2015), and their successful implementation with respect to the benefits for nature, human well-being and societal transformation.

Elegibility:

To be eligible, transnational research consortia must be composed of eligible research partners from minimum 3 different countries financially participating in the Call and requesting support from minimum 3 different Funding Organisations; including at least two different EU Member States or EU Associated Countries. Participants from the low- to middle-income countries are automatically eligible for funding, for example, Colombia.

Benefits:

41 Funding Organisations from 34 countries are joining this call and have reserved – together with the European Commission – a total amount of ca. **40,000,000 EUR.**

ATM application-oriented research for air-ground integration and autonomy

Scope:

The challenge is to design and develop concrete innovative applications (that are already TRL1, achieved within SESAR programme or outside) that aim at increasing the level of airground integration, supported by high automation levels and that will enable the transition to trajectory based operations (TBO). The proposed solutions will aim at realising the Digital European Sky vision that foresees the full integration of an increasing number of new forms of mobility and air vehicles, which have a high degree of autonomy and use digital means of communication and navigation.

Eligibility:

Any legal entity, regardless of its place of establishment, including legal entities from nonassociated third countries or international organisations (including international European research organisations) is eligible to participate (whether it is eligible for funding or not), provided that the conditions laid down in the Horizon Europe Regulation have been met, along with any other conditions laid down in the specific call topic. With at least 3 legal entities from 3 different EU or Horizon Europe Associated Countries + international partners.

Contribution:

The grant requested will be between **500,000** and **1,000,000 EUR**.

ERC Synergy Grants

Objective:

The aim is to provide support for a small group of two to four Principal Investigators to jointly address ambitious research problems that could not be addressed by the individual Principal Investigators and their teams working alone. Synergy projects should enable substantial advances at the frontiers of knowledge, stemming, for example, from the cross-fertilization of scientific fields, from new productive lines of enquiry, or new methods and techniques, including unconventional approaches and investigations at the interface between established disciplines. The transformative research funded by Synergy Grants should have the potential of becoming a benchmark on a global scale.

Eligibility:

The ERC actions are open to researchers of any nationality, who intend to conduct their research activity in any EU Member State or Associated Country. Principal Investigators may be of any age and nationality, and may reside in any country in the world at the time of the application.

Indicative Budget:

Synergy Grants may be awarded up to a maximum of **EUR 10.000.000** for a period of 6 years. The maximum amount of grants is reduced pro rata temporis for projects of a shorter duration.








Marie Skłodowska-Curie Doctoral Networks (MSCA DN) open call

Objective:



Eligibility:

Doctoral Networks are open to international consortia of universities, research institutions, businesses, SMEs and other non-academic organisations. They should include:

- at least three independent legal entities, each established in a different EU Member State. (MS) or Horizon Europe Associated Country (AC) and with at least one of them established in an EU Member State.
- on top of this minimum, other organisations from any country in the world can also join.
- specific conditions apply to Industrial and Joint Doctorates.

Benefits:

All areas of research may be funded and Doctoral Networks can last for up to four years. The duration of each fellowship is between three and 36 months. Each beneficiary must recruit at least one doctoral candidate and can also organize secondments for them anywhere in the world. Funding to recruit additional researchers is proposed as an incentive for Industrial and Joint Doctorates.

Programa de Becas de Movilidad Académica entre Instituciones Asociadas a la AUIP 2024

Objetivo:

La finalidad fundamental de estas becas es fomentar las propuestas que ayuden a la cooperación universitaria iberoamericana en el postgrado y faciliten el establecimiento real de un "Espacio Iberoamericano de Educación Superior" entre las universidades asociadas a la AUIP, así como:

- Facilitar el encuentro de académicos e investigadores de distintos países.
- Fomentar el intercambio de experiencias institucionales y el desarrollo de programas de postgrado conjuntos, especialmente en el marco de las convocatorias de Doctorado Iberoamericanos y Dobles Titulaciones Iberoamericanas.

Dirigida a:

Personas adscritas o que pertenezcan a las instituciones asociadas a la AUIP que sean:

- Profesores e investigadores.
- Gestores de programas de postgrado o de actividades relacionadas con su internacionalización.
- Estudiantes de postgrado.

Financiación:

Las ayudas cubren única y exclusivamente el desplazamiento internacional hasta una cuantía máxima de 1,200 EUR.

European Research Council Established by the European Commission



ERC Consolidator Grant

Objective:

ERC Consolidator Grants are designed to support excellent Principal Investigators at the career stage at which they may still be consolidating their own independent research team or programme. Applicant Principal Investigators must demonstrate the ground-breaking nature, ambition and feasibility of their scientific proposal.

Eligibility:

Researchers of any nationality with 7-12 years of experience since completion of PhD, a scientific track record showing great promise and an excellent research proposal can apply. Research must be conducted in a public or private research organisation (known as a Host Institution/HI). It could be the HI where the applicant already works, or any other HI located in one of the EU Member States or Associated Countries.

Indicative Budget:

Consolidator Grants may be awarded up to \in 2 million for a period of 5 years. (pro rata for projects of shorter duration).

However, an additional \in 1 million can be made available to cover eligible "start-up" costs for researchers moving from a third country to the EU or an associated country and/or the purchase of major equipment and/or access to large facilities.

Research Grants on Education: Large

Objective:

The goal for this program is support rigorous, intellectually ambitious and technically sound research that is relevant to the most pressing questions and compelling opportunities in education. We seek to support scholarship that develops new foundational knowledge that may have a lasting impact on educational discourse.

Elegibility:

Non-profit or public colleges, universities, school districts, and research facilities, as well as other non-profit organizations with a 501(c)(3) determination from the Internal Revenue Service IRS (or equivalent non-profit status if the organization is outside of the United States).

Principal Investigators (PIs) and Co-PIs applying for a Small Research Grant on Education must have an earned doctorate in an academic discipline or professional field, or appropriate experience in an education research-related profession.

Indicative budgest:

The proposed budgets for this program are between **\$125,000** and **\$500,000** in total.

The Catalyst Fund

Objective:

The Catalyst Fund is geared towards small and/or early-stage ideas and projects that need a capital infusion to launch or prove viability. Catalyst awardees are typically piloting a program, venturing into new territory, on the cusp of launching, or pivoting in a new direction.

The Catalyst Fund supports big ideas or projects that depart from the status quo and require us to look at a problem and its solution in a new light. These big ideas have a high potential for impact across an entire community, city, or country. They tend to leverage existing infrastructure, build on partnerships (public and private), and improve on what's already out there. Big ideas push boundaries and challenge convention.

Elegibility:

Eligible candidates for the Catalyst Fund may be individuals, teams of individuals, non-profit organizations, or social enterprises. To be eligible, all applicants must:

- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Submit an application in English.
- Include completed responses to all required application questions.
- Agree to all legal terms and conditions of the Catalyst Fund grant program.
- Be able to legally receive grant funding.

Indicative budgest:

The Catalyst Fund makes grants between **\$2,500-\$15,000.**

Global Innovation Fund

Objective:

They seek innovations that we believe have the greatest potential to improve the lives of millions of people living in poverty. They support innovations designed to benefit those living on the equivalent of \$5 a day, and are particularly interested in funding innovative solutions that impact those living on less than \$2 a day or other vulnerable or disadvantaged groups.

The innovation must be new approach which differs from solutions which are already widely practiced. This could be a new business model, policy practice, technology, or new ways of delivering products and services that benefit the poor.

Elegibility:

Social enterprises, for-profit companies, non-profit organisations, government agencies, international organisations, and research institutions in any country. It is recommended that individual innovators, entrepreneurs, or researchers apply through an affiliated organisation.

Indicative budgest:

The Global Innovation Fund uses a phased funding approach to manage risk wisely:

- 1. Pilot Stage: Up to 230.000 USD.
- 2. Test & Transition Stage: Up to 2.300.000 USD.
- 3. Scale Stage: Up to 15.000.000 USD.





Short-Term Grants: supporting CSO initiatives to address urgent gaps on women's influence in peace processes.

Objective:



Provide civil society organizations with the opportunity to initiate urgent projects that address various obstacles to women's meaningful participation in a formal peace process or in the implementation of a peace agreement. The type of initiatives may include advocacy campaigns for women's participation in peace negotiations, preparatory and training sessions to engage women in decision-making processes, strategic planning to access and engage with key decision-makers, organizing and drafting participatory statements to influence a peace process, mechanisms to monitor the gender provisions of a peace agreement, etc.

Elegibility:

The lead applicant organization must have legal status and must submit proof of legal registration with the application package. Exceptionally, a registration in another country can be accepted if the registration in the country of intervention is complicated due to conflict.

Indicative Budget:

Grants are awarded up to 100,000 USD for a project for a maximum period of six months.
