Kaleidoscope-Pro Only Grant Option

Objective:

Offer a grant program to support the advancement of wildlife research, habitat monitoring, and environmental conservation. This quarterly grant program provides scientists with bioacoustics research tools to further their study of bats, birds, amphibians, and other vocal wildlife. Here are some highlights:

- Streamlined application for those wanting Kaleidoscope Pro only
- Unlimited Kaleidoscope Pro licenses for eligible applicants
- One-year, annual memberships awarded quarterly
- Applicants may reapply

Elegibility:

Grant recipients must be associated with a charitable, educational, NGOs, or other tax-exempt organization. Consideration will be given to projects that make significant and novel use of wildlife vocalization recordings for data collection and/or analysis.

Benefits:

Wildlife Acoustics may award up to **\$12,000** worth of **eligible products** to selected grant recipients worldwide every quarter. Individual applicants may request products and software licenses totaling up to **\$4,000** quarterly. We will highlight grant recipients and their projects on our website and social media platforms.

HMGCC Co-Creation Challenge: Novel AI Pen Testing

Objective:

HMGCC is co-ordinating a Co-Creation challenge to further the security community's understanding of AI or any novel technologies that have the capacity to penetration test secure IT environments. Scripting based technologies are excluded as these are mature and available as commercial products.

This Co-Creation challenge aims to evaluate the readiness of the technologies, their capabilities and integration needs. This will be achieved by evaluating ease of adaption and integration.

Elegibility:

This challenge is open to sole innovators, industry, academic and research organisations of all types and sizes. There is no requirement for security clearances.

Solution providers or direct collaboration from countries listed by the UK government under trade sanctions and/or arms embargoes, are not eligible for HMGCC Co-Creation challenges.

Indicative budget:

Budget per single organisation, up to **£60,000** per workstream (plus call-off). Project duration **12 weeks**.

Objetivo:

Seleccionar una propuesta para el diseño e implementación de los Centros de Interés en CTeI con enfoque STEM+ mediante la metodología del Programa Ondas con el fin de promover el desarrollo de competencias y habilidades del Siglo XXI para la formación integral de niños, niñas y adolescentes de educación preescolar, básica y media en el marco de las estrategias de ampliación y resignificación del tiempo escolar hasta en 210 establecimientos educativos domiciliados en seis departamentos: Antioquia, Bolívar, Tolima, Huila, Putumayo y Nariño.

Dirigido a:

Instituciones de educación superior (IES) públicas con acreditación institucional de alta calidad domiciliadas en el territorio nacional en alianza estratégica con una institución de educación superior (IES) pública o privada y un centro de ciencia, centros/institutos de investigación o centros de desarrollo tecnológico reconocidos por el Ministerio de Ciencia, Tecnología e Innovación.

Duración y financiación:

El plazo de ejecución del proyecto será de ocho (8) meses, según los tiempos referidos en los numerales 5.2 y 5.3 sobre las etapas del proyecto. Apply for funding – EOCA

Objective:

EOCA funds projects which benefit biodiversity in a wild landscape. Our definition of 'landscape' includes marine environments, and a broad range of wild, non-urban spaces. Projects must conserve, protect, enhance, restore, and/or reconnect habitats within a given landscape that are particularly important for the biodiversity there.

Project applications MUST:

- protect a threatened species or habitat;
- have a link to the outdoor enthusiast (see Funding Criteria for full details); AND
- involve hands-on practical conservation work.

Eligibility:

Non profit organisations can apply to EOCA for grants in any country around the world except North America (US and Canada – where the Conservation Alliance provides funding for conservation efforts from the North American outdoor industry).

Benefits:

All grants awarded are for the time period of up to two years, for a maximum budget of **€30,000**, and if you are successful, the grant will be given in 3 stages over the course of the time period.

Elegibility:

Non-profit or public colleges, universities, school districts, and research facilities, as well as other non-profit organizations with a 501(c)(3) determination from the Internal Revenue Service IRS (or equivalent non-profit status if the organization is outside of the United States).

Principal Investigators (PIs) and Co-PIs applying for a Small Research Grant on Education must have an earned doctorate in an academic discipline or professional field, or appropriate experience in an education research-related profession.

Indicative budget:

Proposed budgets for this program are limited to **USD 50,000** total and may not include indirect cost charges per Spencer's policy. Projects proposed may not be longer than 5 years in duration.

Dirigido a:

Entidades del Sistema Nacional de Ciencia, Tecnología e Innovación (SNCTI) que tengan grupos de investigación, desarrollo tecnológico e innovación con reconocimiento vigente del Ministerio de Ciencia, Tecnología e Innovación al cierre de la presente convocatoria, que se presenten individualmente o en alianza con otras entidades del SNCTI.

Duración y financiación:

El término de duración de los proyectos a financiar será de hasta catorce (14) meses.

Las propuestas presentadas podrán solicitar en financiación un monto máximo por línea temática cómo se relaciona:

Russell E. Train Fellowships

Objective:

WWF's Russell E. Train Education for Nature Program (EFN) invites applications from aspiring and experienced researchers, practitioners, and leaders to pursue graduate-level studies (master's and PhD) geared towards research that cultivates a better understanding of the place-based nature of food systems and transformation. There is substantial evidence at the global scale of the urgent need for food system transformation, but less attention has been paid to how transformations toward more healthy and sustainable food systems might play out at the national level.

The aim of the Food Systems Fellowship is to support outstanding master's or doctoral students to develop evidence-based, innovative, and interdisciplinary research on food systems at the national level to catalyze the process of generating an improved understanding of the country-specific nature of food systems and transformation.

Elegibility:

The fellowship is open to nationals of eligible countries within WWF-US priority areas who are already enrolled/are interested in enrolling in a master's or PhD program. Eligible countries include: Belize, Bhutan, Bolivia, Brazil, Cambodia, Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chile, **Colombia**, etc.

Indicative budget:

Applicants may apply for up to **two years** of funding and request up to **\$30,000** per year. The amount of funding approved will vary.

Objective:

SwedBio supports a limited number of strategic initiatives through our 'Collaborative Partner Implementation Pathway'. To collaborate with SwedBio and receive support, an application must align with SwedBio's themes, approaches and principles.

Themes: Livelihood, food & health; Cities & biodiversity; Biocultural diversity; Climate change & ecosystems; and Values & governance.

Approches: Dialogues & learning; Art & culture; and Communication & training.

Elegibility:

- Civil society organisations, including Indigenous peoples and local communities' organisations
- International organisations
- Institutes
- Universities

In particular, regional and global networks with projects of regional and global relevance. These projects are primarily implementing activities and based in OECD DAC list developing countries*.

Indicative budget:

SwedBio contributes to shorter projects through our small-grants support (total support corresponding to maximum **SEK 500,000**) and to longer, multi-year projects.

Objective:

At Transition to Scale (TTS), Being will support promising innovations that have achieved proof-of-concept or demonstrated initial positive results of the innovation and have significant potential to achieve sustainable impact at scale or as it reaches more people. Our goal is to support innovators to Transition to Scale through the 'missing middle'. They're funding bold prevention and promotion ideas that address the early drivers of mental health and wellbeing for the most underserved young people aged 10- to 24 in: Colombia, Ecuador, Ghana, India, Indonesia, Morocco, Pakistan, Romania, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Tanzania, and Vietnam.

Eligibility:

All legally incorporated (or the equivalent) organizations based in any country can apply for funding through this RFP. Please note: Only organizations implementing their project in the 12 priority countries.

Indicative budget

TTS funding between **\$300,000 CAD** and **\$1,500,000 CAD** over **12-48 months** will be awarded to support organizations that align with country-specific priorities along their scaling journey to help catalyze their sustainability and impact.

Research Grants on Education: Large

Objective:

The goal for this program is to support rigorous, intellectually ambitious and technically sound research that is relevant to the most pressing questions and compelling opportunities in education.

Eligibility:

Non-profit or public colleges, universities, school districts, and research facilities, as well as other non-profit organizations with a 501(c)(3) determination from the Internal Revenue Service IRS (or equivalent non-profit status if the organization is outside of the United States).

Principal Investigators (PIs) and Co-PIs applying for a Small Research Grant on Education must have an earned doctorate in an academic discipline or professional field, or appropriate experience in an education research-related profession.

Indicative budget:

Large Research Grant budget totals should be between **\$125,000** and **\$500,000**, including up to 15% indirect cost charges. We anticipate funding proposals in the following funding tiers: \$125,000 to 250,000; \$250,001 to \$375,000; and \$375,001 to \$500,000.

The Branco Weiss Fellowship for Society in Science

Objective:

The Branco Weiss Fellowship – Society in Science is a community of exceptional young scientists who share a passion for taking research beyond the mainstream. Fellows are given the means to pursue their personal vision of a particular scientific project independently – in the best possible locations, anywhere in the world.

Eligibility:

- The Fellowship is open to researchers from all disciplines and to citizens of all nationalities. There are no restrictions on biological age.
- At the time of the submission deadline, applicants must hold a doctorate (PhD) or must have successfully passed their doctoral examination. Applicants must have obtained their doctorate (PhD) a maximum of five years before the submission deadline. The date of the examination or of the certificate is decisive.
- Professors and lecturers with or without tenure or tenure track are not eligible to apply for a fellowship.
- Scientists with a permanent employment are not eligible to apply for a fellowship.

Benefits:

Research projects should be conceived to last five years. A Branco Weiss Fellowship amounts to max. **CHF 600,000** for up to **five years**. It may be used to cover all legitimate costs of research (i.e. salary and/or equipment, travel expenses, consumables, personnel, etc.).
